# Step 1

- ▶ Talk with your colleagues.

# Step 2

# Step 3

- ▶ Consider legal implications.
- ▶ Don't tell your boss.



# Step 4

- ▶ Implement your decision.
- ▶ Either
  - ▶ don't tell your boss or
  - ▶ show what will happen if the decision is not implemented

# Step 5

Repeat  
(the most important step)
